## RECREATION CLUB UPDATE

With the easing of Government Covid restrictions, the following changes will take affect from 6:00AM on Monday, 29 March 2021.

Residents will no longer be required to use the online booking system to use the facilities and sessions times are no longer applicable.

To ensure we meet government requirements for contact tracing, all residents must sign in using the QR Code at the entrance and show that you have completed the check in to the employee on duty.

To enter the facility, you will need to swipe your Sanctuary Lakes Card for access. If your card has expired or is inactive, please contact reception on 03 9394 9400 or [ocmanager@sanctuarylakes.com.au](mailto:ocmanager@sanctuarylakes.com.au). Please remember, no card no entry.

A density quotient of 1 per 2sqm applies to each space.

The sauna will reopen. To ensure a density quotient of 1 per 2sqm a maximum of 3 people can be in the sauna at any given time.

Residents must wipe down the equipment after each use, using the cleaning products provided. This is usual Recreation Club etiquette with or without Covid restrictions.

The Recreation Club staff will continue to wipe down the equipment every hour.
