A Diwali event will take place at The Breezewater Reserve in Sanctuary Lakes from 3 PM to 10 PM on Saturday, 26 October, 2024. This event, approved by Wyndham City Council, will include:

- Amusement rides
- Kids' activities (face painting and henna)
- Food and merchandise stalls
- Cultural performances
- Fireworks display

While this is not a Sanctuary Lakes event, we have been in discussions with Wyndham City Council and the Event Organiser and requested the following of them to minimise disruptions:

- 1. Parking Compliance officers will be onsite to educate attendees and issue notices for parking violations.
- 2. VMS boards will direct attendees to park at the shopping centre, as no parking is allowed at the event site, and no event parking will be accommodated within the Estate.
- 3. Shuttle buses will run between the Sanctuary Lakes Boulevard entry and the site, with a second loop service collecting attendees from the southern end of the estate to help reduce parking and traffic congestion.

We have recently received some feedback/complaints regarding parking issues around the estate and wanted to remind everyone of some key guidelines to ensure smooth and safe parking for all residents.

#### **Parking Guidelines:**

- **Two-Way Streets:** When parking on a two-way street, you must park on the left-hand side of the road. Your vehicle should face the direction of travel, with the passenger side parked next to the kerb.
- Public Parking Bays: Parking bays managed by Wyndham City Council are for public use. Even if a
  parking bay is in front of your property, other vehicles are allowed to park there. If parked in a
  designated parking bay, ensure your vehicle is within the marked lines vehicles parked in parking bays
  must be road registered.
- Footpaths and Nature Strips: You cannot stop on a footpath, shared path, or nature strip adjacent to a
  road in a built-up area unless there is permissive signage. Victorian Road Rules prohibit parking across
  or blocking access to a footpath. Do not obstruct access to or from a footpath ramp, as this can
  impede pedestrians, particularly those in wheelchairs, motorised wheelchairs, and prams. Two wheels
  up on a footpath is not permitted.
- **Council Obligations:** Wyndham City Council is legally obligated to enforce Victorian Road Rules, including those related to parking on nature strips.
- Vehicle Sales: Wyndham City Council's Local Laws prohibit the sale of vehicles on roads or Councilcontrolled land.
- **Loading Zones:** The loading zone area in the main waterfront building car park is reserved for suppliers and emergency vehicles only. Please do not use this area for parking when attending the gym. If the loading bay is occupied and emergency vehicles are needed, they will have no space to park.






## Fireworks Pet Safety Tips
