The next steps in the process for suburb recognition

As you may already know, the suburb consultation period ended at 5pm on Wednesday 18 April, 2018. We'd like to thank all the residents that took the time to fill out the survey; giving their feedback on whether Sanctuary Lakes should become a suburb in its own right, along with the boundaries of the proposed suburb.

Wyndham City Council (WCC) has advised that it will take between 30-60 days to prepare a report on the consultation. Once this is complete, it will be presented to WCC Councillors for their consideration. At the council meeting following the release of the report to Councillors (potentially in June or July), the Councillors will vote on whether they support the proposal for Sanctuary Lakes to be recognised as a suburb. If Councillors support the proposal, it will then be submitted to the Office of Geographic Names. We continue to encourage residents to contact council representatives to express your thoughts and ask further questions.
