## Waterfront Building Redevelopment Project 04/19 Updates

## 18/11/2022

Sanctuary Lakes Resort Services (SLRS) released an update to Lot Owners and Residents regarding the Waterfront Building Redevelopment Project (04/19) on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2022. The update informed that on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2022, the SLRS Board voted to re-commence 'Phase 1' of the Project, as it was put on hold back in March 2020 due to COVID-19.

The Project would re-start by:

- Reviewing the options and uses originally suggested together with costings
  - o Are the same things important to the community?
- Refining the engagement model and community consultation process
  - o Introducing an evidence based Deliberative Engagement Approach facilitated by an independent engagement consultant.

SLRS would be recommencing consultation with Lot Owners therefore invited Lot Owners to express their interest in the exciting opportunity to join a Community Panel who will explore potential opportunities for the Waterfront Buildings revitalisation. Revitalisation and change would ensure that the Waterfront Building was a great destination, represented the lifestyle that the resort offers and meets the needs of the Sanctuary Lakes community now and into the future.

The EOI closed at 11:59PM Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and a Community Panel of 26 individuals were randomly selected by our independent engagement consultants Capire, on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2022. To the best of its ability, the Community Panel represent the diversity of the Sanctuary Lakes community.

The Community Panel were provided with a Welcome Pack on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2022, in readiness for the first in-person workshop.

## THE FIRST COMMUNITY PANEL SESSION WAS HELD THURSDAY 17TH NOVEMBER 2022

This successful introductory session:

- Helped the Panel get familiar with the project history, the team and each other
- Introduced the participants to their role, purpose and outcomes of the sessions
- Presented key information on the Waterfront Building Redevelopment project

Session 2 takes place on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and will focus on the Community Panel finalising the assessment criteria and exploring the options.
